Conferences are next week WEDNESDAY 16 and THURSDAY 17th March.

There is a 1pm finish for students on Wednesday 16th ONLY.

In 2022 our reporting schedule will be goal setting conferences in Term 1 with written reports and student-led conferences at the end of Term 2, and a further written report at the end of Term 4.

Reports this year will be online, and accessed via the parent portal as we did at the end of last year. We are here to help you - Please [contact the office](#) if you are new to our school, or need new login details.

As always, anytime you have a question or concern about your child's learning or progress please make an appointment to see the Kaitiaki or Hub teachers.

This term's Goal setting Conferences are on Wednesday 16th and Thursday 17th March.

All students will be dismissed from classes at 1pm on Wednesday 16th.

Please may we ask you to organise to collect your child/ren or organise alternate care. See below.

Conferences will be held via Zoom with you and your child. Once you have booked your appointment details of how to join will be emailed out by teachers. If you are unfamiliar with Zoom, you may find [this link](#) or [this video](#) useful.

Discussions will be guided by questions such as:

- What's on top for you? Is there anything in particular you would like to discuss?
- What's something you are proud of that you want to share?
- What are you (child) /is your child passionate about?
- Is there anything you feel your child would benefit from extra support or challenge in?
- If you had one thing you wanted to get out of this year, what would it be?
- What's the best way to communicate with you?
- Is there anything that teachers would benefit from being aware of that might impact on your child's school life?

Conferences this term are for all students in all teams

- For some students the focus of the conferences may be more about settling back to school, than setting specific goals.
- Goal-setting conferences involve a 3-way discussion between parent, child and teacher to establish goals across academic curriculum, our social expectations and the Reremoana School Language of Learning
- Bookings for Goal setting conferences will be in 10-minute slots, with 5 minutes in between to allow the next family to connect.
- If you have something you would like to discuss with the teacher without your child present, please make an alternative appointment for this.
- If teachers are unwell in this current climate, some kaitiaki groups may need to be moved to a different day.
