In 2023 our reporting schedule will be goal-setting conferences in Term 1 with written reports and student-led conferences at the end of Term 2 and a further written report at the end of Term 4. As always, anytime you have a question or concern about your child's learning or progress please make an appointment to see the Kaitiaki or Hub teachers.

This term's Goal setting conference bookings are on **Wednesday 8th either online or in-person** and **Thursday 9th March online only**.

**All students will be dismissed from classes at 1pm on Wednesday 8th.**

Please may we ask you to organise to collect your child/ren or organise alternate care. Please indicate using the survey questions below make sure you scroll down to the bottom of the page if you have more than one child.

- Wednesday you have the option to book an in-person conference OR an online conference. Please make this clear when you book by writing in the caregiver note if it is in person or online. (if you do not specify we will assume an in-person conference)
- Thursday you can book an online conference only.

Conferences that are booked for **online conferences** will be held via Zoom with you and your child. Once you have booked your appointment the link to the meeting will be updated in the booking, to access the booking link press on the arrow to link to the zoom meeting. Conferences this term are for all students in all teams

- Goal-setting conferences involve a 3-way discussion between parent, child and teacher to establish goals across academic curriculum, our social expectations and the Reremoana School Language of Learning
- Bookings for Goal setting conferences will be in 10-minute slots, with 2 minutes in between to allow the next family to connect if online
- If you have something you would like to discuss with the teacher without your child present, please make an alternative appointment for this.
- If teachers are unwell in this current climate, some kaitiaki groups may need to be moved to a different day.
