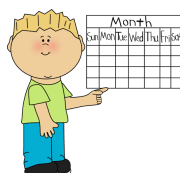

Technology

Every term our Year 7 and 8 students take part in a skills technology programme. This is a full two day programme. Year 7 students will have experiences in coding, fabrics and building structures, while Year 8 students will have experiences in food, robotics and electronics.

Languages

Our second languages programme continues this term - Year 8 students will be exposed to Afrikaans and Mandarin, our Year 7s will be learning German and Te Reo and our Year 6s will be looking at Sign Language.

Speeches Term 2

Students are to prepare a three minute oratory on a topic of their own choice. An oratory is a particular type of speech whose purpose is to persuade people. We will be doing teaching of persuasive writing in class and giving students time to work on speeches. They will also be expected to work on these speeches at home.

Sports in the Kereru Team

Year 7 and 8 students compete in the Central Counties Sports Cluster. Students are invited to sign up for a range of sports, teams get selected on merit as it is part of our gifted and talented programme. We also run a team sports programme at school.
