Re: MEASLES

Kia ora Parents and Guardians

As you know, Auckland (especially Counties Manukau) is currently in the middle of a measles epidemic. Health authorities are telling us that more people are likely to contract measles over the next few days and weeks.

So far, our school has NOT had any confirmed cases of measles. However we want to be prepared. We are in the process of ensuring that our immunization records are up to date, and in cases where we do not have proof of vaccination on file school staff will be contacting those parents and requesting a copy of vaccination records.

The Board of Trustees wishes to inform our community that in the event of a confirmed case of measles at Reremoana School **all students and staff who are not fully vaccinated (and proof provided) will be required to stay at home in quarantine for up to 10 school days.**

The health and wellbeing of our students and staff is of paramount importance to us.

Thank you for your help, we will keep you advised of what is happening.
