## This Term in Pukeko Team

### Literacy

Letters and Sounds groups have been set up in order to support students best to their phonetic needs. Students are read to daily by their teacher, join in with shared reading, guided reading and independent reading activities, including reading comprehensions and Reading Eggs.

### Maths

This term in Maths students will continue to learn about number and algebra, geometry and measure and statistics. Continue to supplement this learning, by using Mathletics at home.

### Inquiry

## Reading

Thank you, for your response to our reading survey in Term 2 around reading at home and reading engagement. Thank you for your questions that you posed to us regarding our reading programmes and how you can support your child better at home. A common theme among the questions was about the systems and strategies that school use to teach reading. In response to this the school are planning to hold two different zoom session around the reading system and strategies with helpful hints and tips.

Whilst we do not set homework for reading, each child will bring home a reader, to read every night, it could be that they have the text for 2/3 nights to familiarise themselves with new vocabulary. Children do have access to their Reading Eggs account and time can be spent on this as an additional reading activity.

This Term we are taking part in a Spellathon, and children will have words to read and spell, some may also have High Frequency sight words to practise.

It is important for students to bring their book bags to school daily, so that they can bring class reading books and library books home to share.
