

AFTERNOON DROP ZONE ACCESS

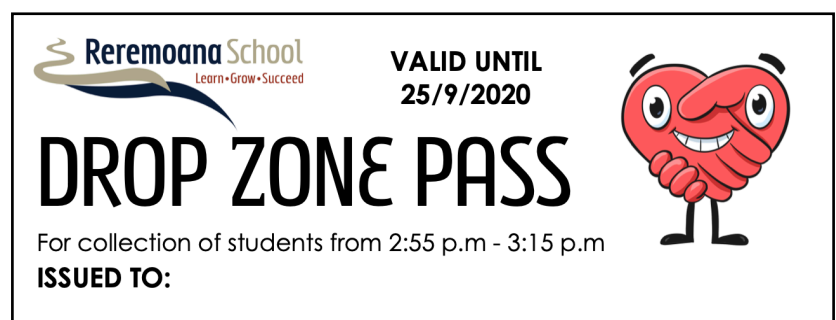
From June 8th in the afternoons, **the drop zone will be coned off until 2:55pm**. After this time, only those with a **Drop Zone Pass** will be able to access the drop zone.

- Passes will be issued or re-issued termly, or can be given for a short period of time (e.g. if someone is in a moon boot).
- Only vehicles displaying the pass on their dashboard will be admitted to the drop zone in the afternoons
- On both sides of the drop zone, drivers are asked to pull up to the top of the drop zone (pedestrian end) to allow for others to more easily pull in behind.
- For cars on the left hand side of the drop zone (school side), drivers are to remain in their vehicles.
- If parked on the right hand side (Scotsmoor side) of the drop zone, we ask that an adult walks the child/ren across to the parked car.
- Please, no double parking/stopping in the middle of the drop zone to let children into the car.
- If the drop zone is full, the staff member monitoring the drop zone entry will not admit cars, and will ask that you park elsewhere or "go around the block." Please respect this.
- Please don't 'line up' behind the cones on Scotsmoor prior to access being granted access at 2:55 p.m. This presents obvious risks. Please drive around the block or park elsewhere.
- Drop zone passes may be rescinded if guidelines are not adhered to.

Criteria for Drop Zone Pass - Please complete this [form](#) if you meet criteria,

- Mobility issues (adult or child)
- Elderly person regularly collects your child
- Baby/toddler in the car

If you have another reason for needing to use the drop zone, please request consideration for this via the form in the link above Applications have been extended to close tomorrow, Friday June 5th, at 9am. Those who meet the criteria via their application will receive their Drop Zone Pass via their child tomorrow.

Cross Country Training


