Communicating via Email

It is our policy to respond to emails within 24 hours during the week. Please do not expect staff to be checking and responding to emails over the weekend,

Who do I Contact with Questions or Concerns?

The first point of contact is, more often than not, your child's kaitiaki teacher, especially when it is in regard to your child or things happening in their team/class. If they are unable to help, your query may be directed to the relevant Team Leader or member of the senior leadership team. All staff email addresses can be found via out website - Our People.

The office frequently fields calls about things that have been shared via our newsletter. This is another reason to ensure that you are taking time to read them each Thursday, and make note of dates.events/items relevant to your child and family.

KEEPING OUR HANDS AND FEET TO OURSELVES

We have noticed an increase in incidents where children have been hurting others at break times. These are often as a result of 'play fights' or games getting out of hand and escalating. We have had to pause some kinds of play (e.g. tag) while we teach children effective and safe ways of playing such as having a nominated umpire.

We are also noticing a need for greater conflict resolution strategies. Conflict and disagreements are part of life for both adults and students and we need to teach children ways of dealing with this.

This article might be a useful read.

We urge you all to discuss the importance of keeping our hands and feet to ourselves with your children, how they might deal with conflict and getting help from a teacher.
