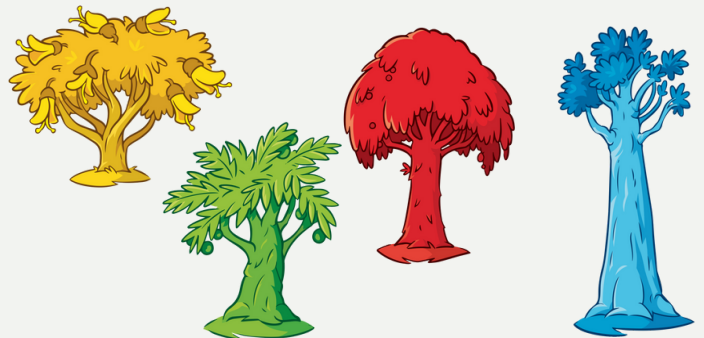
Discussions will be guided by questions such as:
