Catherine Gallagher is a clinical psychologist with over 20 years' experience in the public and private sectors. A lot of this time has been spent focused on supporting children, young people and their whānau around a number of issues, including anxiety.

**ABOUT OUR WORKSHOP**

Anxiety can affect how tamariki and rangatahi see themselves, learn, and understand their place in the world.

**This workshop will give you tools to:**

Understand what anxiety is and why it might show up in your tamariki. Recognise the signs early, at home and in daily life. Support brave behaviour, even when things feel hard. Help your tamariki feel confident, safe and connected. Keep anxiety from limiting opportunities and experiences. Look after your own wellbeing so you have the energy to support them.

Practical strategies you can use straightaway. Ideas for keeping communication open with your child. Reassurance that you are not alone in this journey.

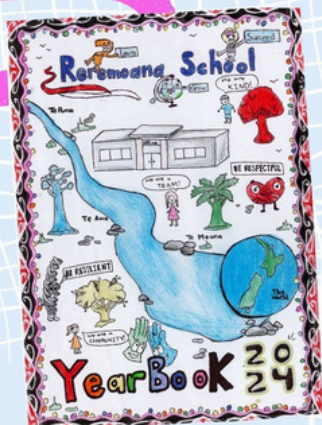
