## This Term

### Literacy

Our BSLA reading and writing programme is underway. You will receive weekly whanau handouts via HERO, to help you with your child's learning. Weekly assignments will be uploaded to Reading Eggs to supplement the classwork.

### Maths

This term in Maths, students will learn about Fractions and Measurement. In Measurement, we will be looking at time, length, perimeter, and area. Additional work will be set on Maths Seeds.

A key part of understanding how fractions work is the connection to multiplication and division. Here is what each year level needs to know Y2: 2s, 5s, 10s, Y3: 2s, 3, 4s, 5s, 8s, 10s. If you would like to support at home, then please focus on one set of facts at a time, and once your child is confident, move on to the next.

### Inquiry

We are excited to share a glimpse into our upcoming learning journey for our Planet Earth and Beyond inquiry unit. This term, our tamariki will be looking up at the stars and exploring our place in the universe through a unique lens that combines modern science with Mātauranga Māori (Māori knowledge). By exploring both perspectives, students will develop a deeper appreciation for the world around us and the rich cultural heritage of Aotearoa.
