

COMMENCEMENT OF MODULAR BUILDINGS PROJECT

In last week's newsletter I advised that the building of two new classrooms to be situated in the space between the hall and Kiwi/Piwakawaka Hub 1 block, was due to get underway this term.

We have had notification that the process will begin this coming Monday, August 16th.

Throughout the building process, the area beside the hall and including to the gate by the turf, will be fenced off as a secure compound. **This means there will be no access to school from the Scotsmoor gate by the crossing/turf.** as was the case when the turf was being installed last year. The crossing itself will still be in use.

We will want to avoid increased use of the drop zone, particularly in the afternoons, when building begins. Should we find that the drop zone is under increased pressure in the afternoons, it will be closed in the interests of health and safety.

If you are collecting your child by car, please make a meeting place for your child that is not in the drop zone in the afternoons. A good solution is to park in a neighbouring street and encourage your child to use the crossing to come and meet you, or ask them to use one of the other exits (Turnberry or Belfry).

We will advise when any additional disruption and safety considerations are to be expected, for example when the modular buildings will be craned in.
